

FEDERAL CONSTITUTION
SABAH AND SARAWAK (EXECUTIVE POWERS) (SHOTGUNS)
ORDER 1977

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Article 95c of the Constitution the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Sabah and Sarawak (Executive Powers) (Shotguns) Order 1977, and shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1977.

Extension of executive authority.

2. Subject to paragraph 3, the executive authority of the States of Sabah and Sarawak shall extend to the administration of those provisions of the Arms Act 1960 (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "the Act"), which relate to the grant, issue, renewal, refusal, revocation, cancellation and suspension of arms licences and arms permits (but only in respect of shotguns and ammunition therefor) and the Chief Minister of Sabah or of Sarawak, as the case may be, may—

(a) authorize a State officer to exercise and perform those powers and duties, or otherwise provide for their exercise and performance, such exercise and performance to be subject in either case to prior consultation with the Chief Police Officer of the State concerned:

Provided that where no such authorization or provision has been made, the exercise and performance of those powers and duties shall be carried out by the appropriate authority under the Act; and

(b) exercise the power under section 51 of the Act to reduce, remit or refund the fees for arms licences and arms permits in relation to shotguns and ammunition therefor.

Powers of Inspector-General of Police.

3. The Inspector-General of Police may direct as respects any person, any class of persons or any area that for reasons of internal security no arms licence or arms permit shall be issued to any such person or class of persons or to any person in any such area, and the licensing authority shall not issue any arms licence or arms permit in contravention of any such direction.

Appeals.

4. For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that for the purposes of section 24 (3) of the Act—

(a) any appeal arising from the provisions of paragraph 2 (a) in relation to the exercise of powers or the performance of duties under any authorization or other provision made thereunder by the Chief Minister of the State concerned, and any appeal arising from the provisions of paragraph 2 (b), shall be determined by the Yang di-Pertua Negeri of the State concerned; and

(b) any appeal arising from the provisions of paragraph 3 shall be determined by the Minister.

1. This Notification may be cited as the
Shotguns and Ammunition (Licensing Officers)
(Authorisation) Notification, 1978, and shall
be deemed to have come into operation on the
1st day of September, 1977.

2. The officers specified in the first column
of the Schedule are hereby authorised in respect
of the areas specified opposite thereto in the
second column thereof to exercise and perform
those powers and duties under the Arms Act, 1960,
which relate to the grant, issue, renewal,
refusal, revocation, cancellation and suspension
of arms and ammunition licences and arms and
ammunition permits; such exercise and performance
shall be only in respect of shotguns and
ammunition and be subject to prior consultation
with the Commissioner of Police, Sarawak.
